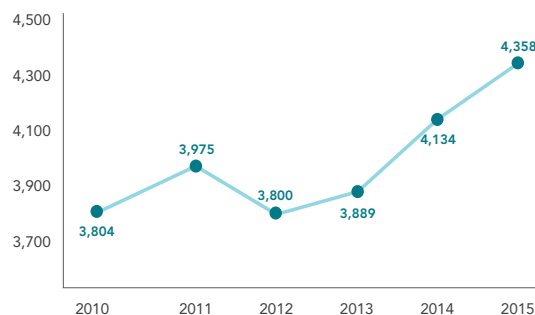

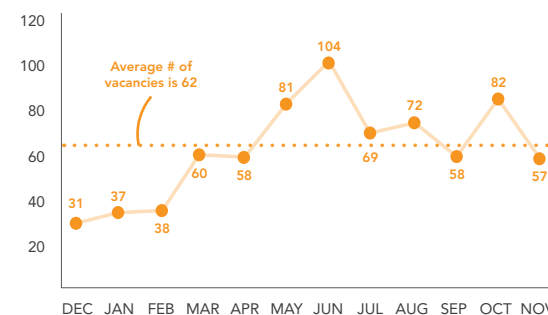

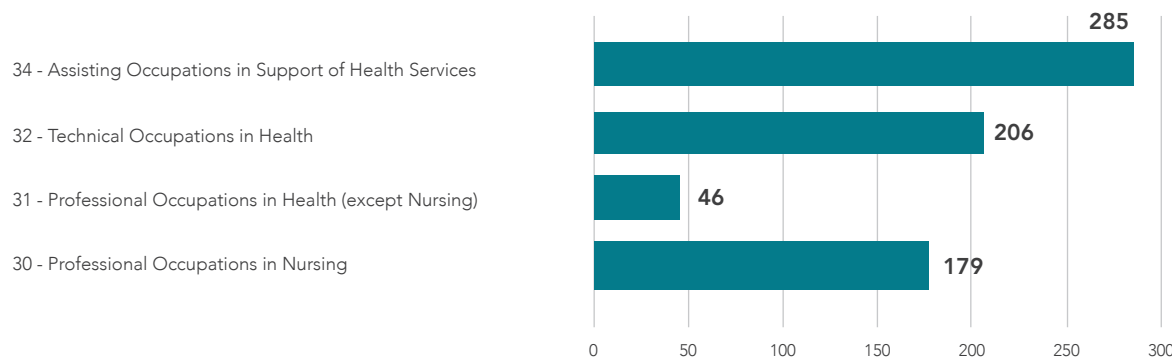
NUMBER OF OCCUPIED JOBS IN HEALTH CARE (NOC 3) PER YEAR, 2010-2015 (StatsCan)

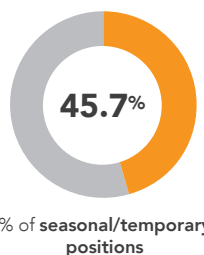

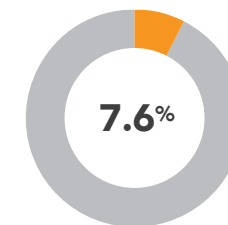

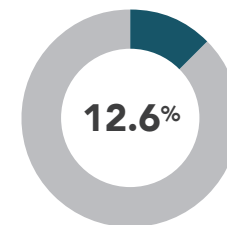

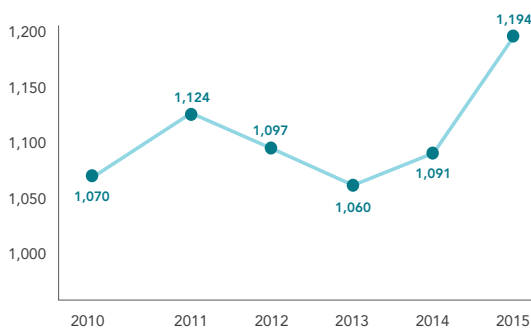

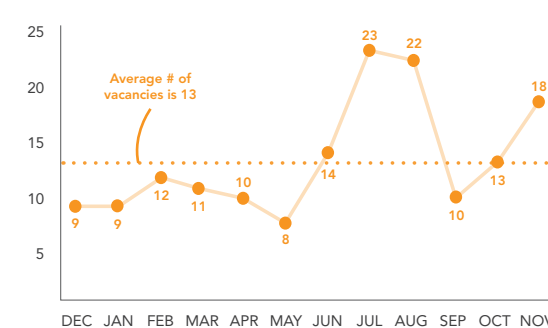

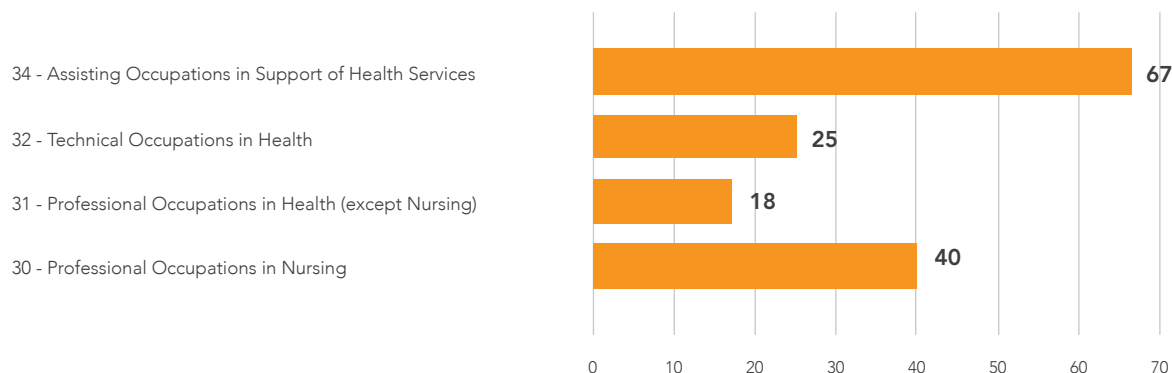
NUMBER OF OCCUPIED JOBS IN HEALTH CARE (NOC 3) PER YEAR, 2010-2015 (StatsCan)
