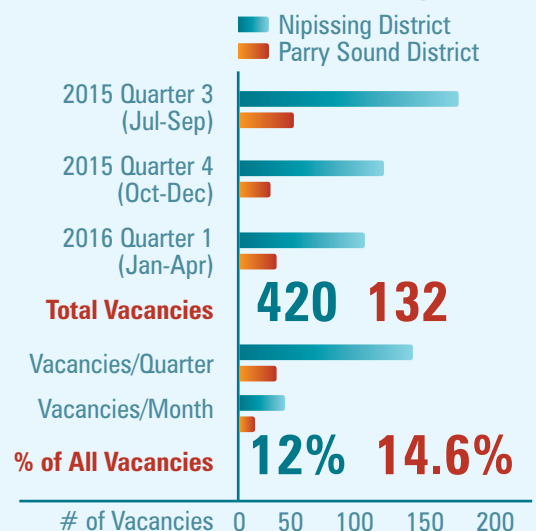

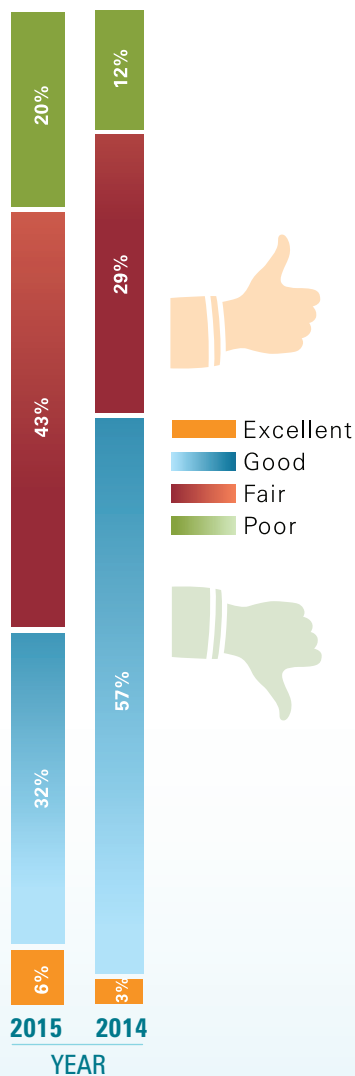

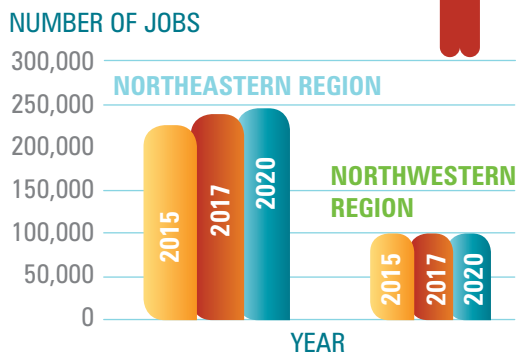

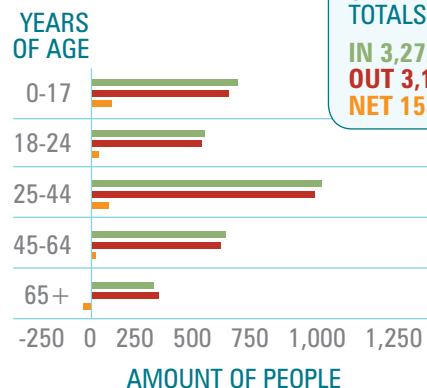


### PROJECTED JOB GROWTH 2015-2020
