A total of 484 vacancies were recorded for Nipissing District throughout the month of June. This represents a large increase; +17.8%, from the previous month total of 411. The June 2017 figure is also notable greater; +8.8%, than the same month last year, where 445 vacancies were recorded. 207 unique employers posted vacancies in the reporting month. Of the 484 vacancies 458 (94.6%) were found through online source, 82 (16.9%) requested a bilingual candidate for the position and 123 (25.4%) required some form of driver's license.

There were 86 vacancies recorded within the Parry Sound district in the month of June. This represents a large; -53.0%, decrease

from the previous month when 183 vacancies were recorded.

The drop was not as dramatic; -26.5%, when compared to the figure of June 2016 of 117 vacancies. 38 unique employers


posted vacancies in June. Of the 86 vacancies 62 (72.1%) were

listed through online sources, none requested a bilingual candidate and 11 (12.8%) required some form of driver's license.




Top 5 Employers Posting Vacancies











The Retail Trade (NAICS-44-45) and Health Care and Social Services (NAICS-62) industries were tied for the greatest number of vacancies in June with 64 reported vacancies, or 13.2% of the overall vacancy share each. The largest change over the previous month was in the Administrative Support, Remediation and Waste Management Services (NAICS-56) industry which dropped in overall vacancy share by -5.2%. The remaining industries remained similar to their previous month share values.

Sales and Service (NOC-6) based occupations led the way again in terms of vacancy share by major occupation with 34.3%, or 166 vacancies recorded in June. This figure does however represent a -4.9% drop from the May share for these occupations; this also represents the largest shift month-over-month amongst all the major occupational classifications. The largest gain; 4.3%, belonged to the Trades, Transportation and Equipment Operators (NOC-7) occupational classification. The remaining major occupational classifications saw minimal changes in vacancy share over the last month.

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The greatest number of vacancies; 26 (30.2%) came from businesses within the Retail Trade (NAICS-44-45) industry. This is a slight increase; +5.6%, from the May vacancy share figure of 30.2% for this industry. The largest drop in vacancy share was seen in the Arts, Entertainment and Recreation (NAICS-71) which went from 16.4% to 1.2% of the vacancy share over the last month. The largest gain was in Public Administration (NAICS-91); increasing 12.5% from 3.8% in May to 16.3% in June.

Exactly half; 50.0%, of the vacancies this month were for Sales and Service (NOC-6) based occupations. This is up 5.2% from the May vacancy share value of 44.8% for this major occupational classification. The greatest increase; +6.5%, was for Manufacturing and Utilities (NOC-9) occupations which made up 8.1% of the share in June. Trades, Transportation and Equipment Operators (NOC-7) based occupations dropped from 15.8% vacancy share in May to only 7.0% in June.

Job postings were gathered online from www.jobbank.gc.ca, www.indeed.ca, and www.wowjobs.ca, and the North Bay & District Jobs Facebook page. They were also gathered from our local newspapers including: Almaguin News, Parry Sound North Star, North Bay Nugget, Mattawa Recorder, and West Nipissing Tribune.
